Wiley, About the book DRG systems were introduced in Europe for similar reasons: first, they should increase the transparency of services which are effectively provided in hospitals and second, DRGbased payment systems should give incentives for the efficient use of resources. In addition, the combination of increased transparency and efficient use of resources was assumed to contribute to improving -- or at least assuring -- the level of quality of care.
